Scheduling Meetings with Lawmakers

LTS delegates have the power to make a difference, to educate and influence minds on Capitol Hill.

State Legislative Chairs are scheduling their state's meetings with their respective House and Senate offices. These meetings will occur on Tuesday, March 8 and if necessary, Wednesday, March 9.

Meetings on the House side will be focused on educating House staff members because lawmakers will be away from the Hill during the District Work period. The Senate will be in session.

NAPS meetings and talking points will focus on postal reform (S. 2051), MSPB appeal rights for all EAS employees (S. 606 and H.R. 1198), windfall elimination penalty reduction (H.R. 711) and equitable retirement for postal police officers (H.R. 2254).

LTS Program

The program will feature:

Sunday: Wreath Laying at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier; Branch President Training; Nondenominational Worship; First Timer's Orientation; Town Hall with NAPS Resident Officers; and State Legislative Chairs Dinner.

Monday: Legislative Training, including remarks by USPS officials and Hill lawmakers.

A SPAC Reception for eligible SPAC donors follows in the evening.

Tuesday and Wednesday: Meetings with House and Senate offices; and meeting debriefings.
