

NAPS Leg/Reg Update - May 1, 2017

Hill Leaders Agree on Budget Until September, Avert Shutdown

House and Senate negotiators on Sunday agreed to an omnibus spending bill to fund the government for the rest of the fiscal year through September 30, a more than \$1 trillion package that provides fresh spending instructions for nearly every corner of the federal government.

For the Postal Service, the measure again includes language directing USPS continuance of 6-day delivery at levels not less than those that existed in 1983, when Congress first required 6-day delivery in the annual government funding measure.

Congress still needs to clear the spending package this week before current appropriations under a continuing resolution expire at midnight on Friday, May 5.
