

The Resident Officers attended a briefing to discuss the recent USPS Data Breach and its impact on employees. Below are the questions and responses that were posed to the Postal Service during the course of this briefing:

What specific information was compromised during the breach?

USPS Response: Employee information; including name, Date of birth, SSN, enter on duty date and retirement date.

To what extent was this information compromised?

USPS Response: The extent of the breach is still being analyzed; however the eOPF was not breached.

Is there a specific time period of information that was compromised?

USPS Response: The extent of the breach is still being analyzed.

Was the information of retired USPS employees compromised? If yes, to what extent?

USPS Response: Yes, retiree data was impacted. It appears that retiree data from May, 2012 forward was breached.

What action has USPS taken to guard against future breaches?

USPS Response: Still analyzing the steps needed. All telecommuting activities have been cancelled and the WebVPN system access has been limited.

Will this breach change USPS initiative on IT Health plan to store employee medical info?

USPS Response: Do not know what effect the breach will have on the IT Health plan initiative.
