

Good Afternoon Everyone,

I hope everything is going well back home in New England. Early this morning, I had a meeting with NAPS Legislative Counsel Bruce Moyer and SPAC Manager Elliot Friedman to discuss our SPAC budget for the 2014 election cycle. This was a very important discussion and there are a few details I wanted to share with you.

First, during the 2012 election cycle, SPAC spent \$78,200.00 on candidates from the New England Area. Additionally, SPAC has **ALREADY** spent \$22,000 on New England candidates for the 2014 election cycle, for a grand total of **\$100,200.00** since November of 2010. Some of our biggest allies in the House and Senate are from New England and as a New England native and NAPS Executive Vice President, I am proud we can support them. Second, and just as important, in the same period SPAC has raised **\$30,659.50** from the New England Area.

You and I both know that New Englander's don't like to take more than they give and that as an area we can do better for SPAC. This is why I feel comfortable in asking you to support SPAC today by donating \$10, \$25 or \$50 on-line right now by clicking this link <http://bit.ly/ZirrVA>. Even better, you can sign up for SPAC payroll deduction through PostalEASE for active employees, and OPM deductions for retirees (instructions attached). Currently, 17 people from the New England Area contribute to SPAC by payroll deduction, and the consistency their donations provide are incredibly important to meeting the SPAC budget.

To those that have given in the past, thank you again for all of your past generosity. I hope both you and those considering donating for the first time will contribute today, and help our area pull its own SPAC weight. In the future, I wish to have the opportunity to thank more of you for your SPAC participation.
